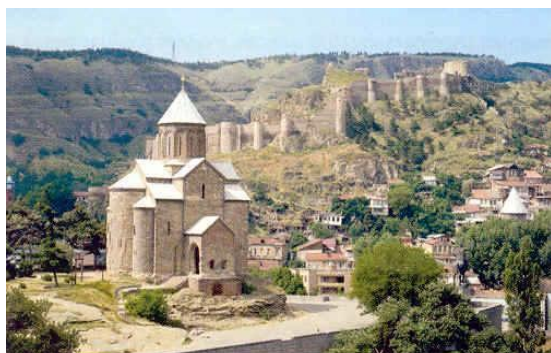

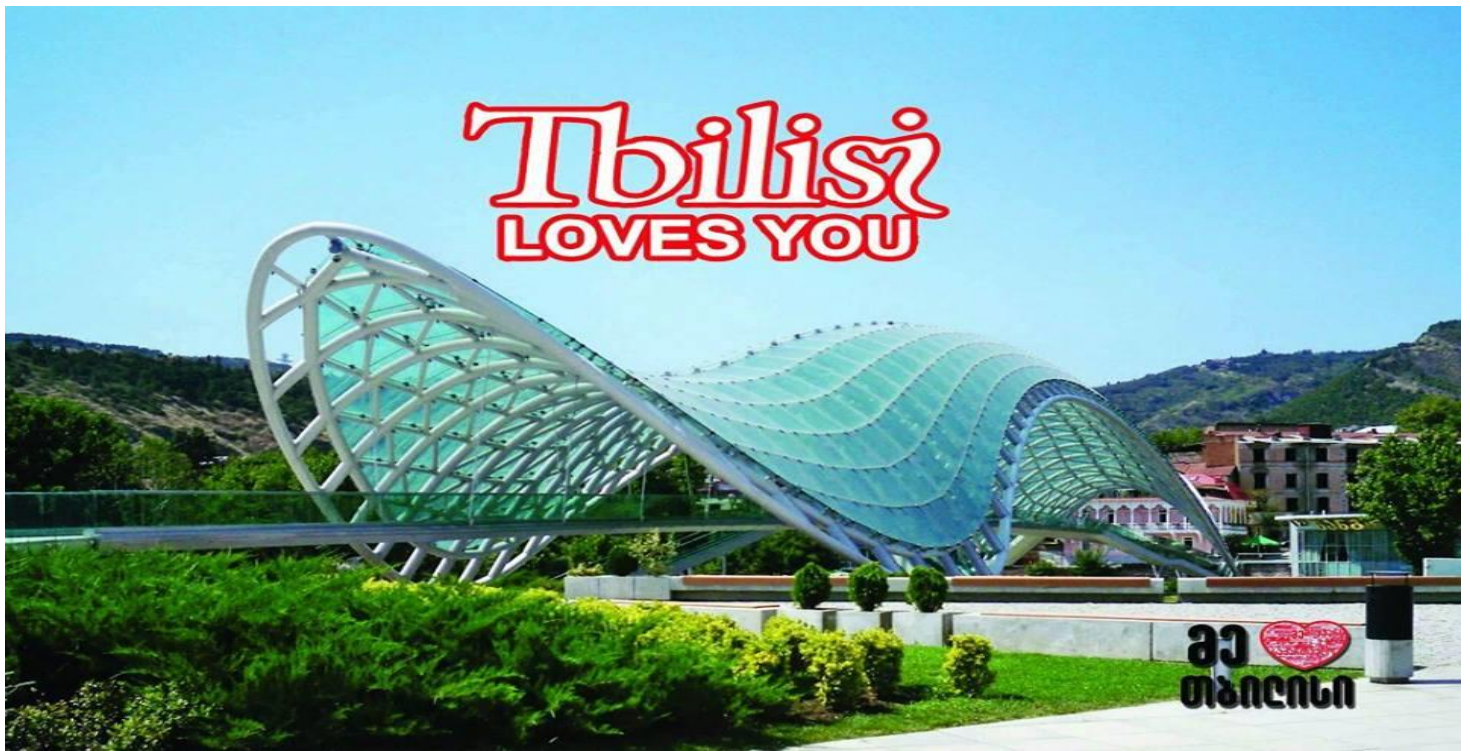

## OVERVIEW OF GEORGIA

A mountainous republic situated in the heart of the Caucasus range, Georgia has borders with Turkey, Armenia, Azerbaijan and Russia. Capital of Georgia is Tbilisi. Tbilisi stands on the banks of the River Mtkvari, in a valley surrounded by hills. Tbilisi is Georgia's main economic and cultural centre.

- The most predominant religion in Georgia is Georgian Orthodox (60%). Other religions in Georgia include Russian Orthodox (10%), Muslim (11%) and Armenian Apostolic (8%).
- The population of Georgia is approx 5.2 million.
- The official language of Georgia is Georgian. In the ethnic territories, Russian, Armenian and Azerbaijani are spoken.

## TBILISI

Georgia's capital Tbilisi lies in the centre of eastern Georgia, in the foothills of the Trialeti mountain range. According to Georgian legends it was founded in the 5th century by King Vakhtang Gorgasali who while hunting shot a pheasant which fell into a warm spring and was either boiled or healed, depending on which version you hear. Either way, the king was inspired to found a city on the site, and the name of the city derives from the Georgian word „tbili” meaning warm. Although the city has been

destroyed and rebuilt some 29 times, the layout of the Old Town is largely intact with narrow alleys and big crooked houses built around courtyards.

## FLIGHTS

### TBILISI International Airport

The Tbilisi international airport is to be the first major airport in Georgia. The airport approximately 2-3 million passenger traffic yearly. The airport located in the heart of the Tbilisi near the city of Tbilisi .

### MONEY

Georgia is a predominantly cash society and according to Georgian law all goods and services should be paid for in local currency (Georgian Lari). However, US dollars are the most widely used and acceptable foreign currency and can easily be exchanged for Georgian Lari at the many currency exchanges in and around Tbilisi and other main Georgian cities. Please note that Lari currency cannot be brought into or taken out of the country. The exchange rate is approx 1 EURO = app. 2.45 Lari, 1 USD = app. 1.76 Lari;

### ELECTRICITY

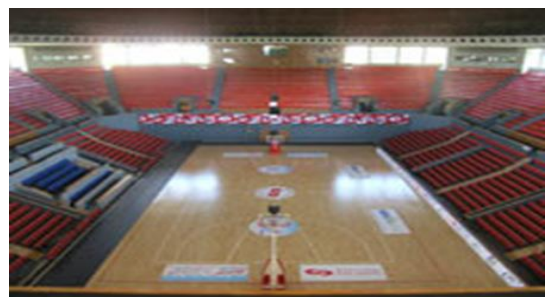
The voltage in Tbilisi is 220 Volts, 50 HZ. The electricity outlets are two-pronged, European standard.

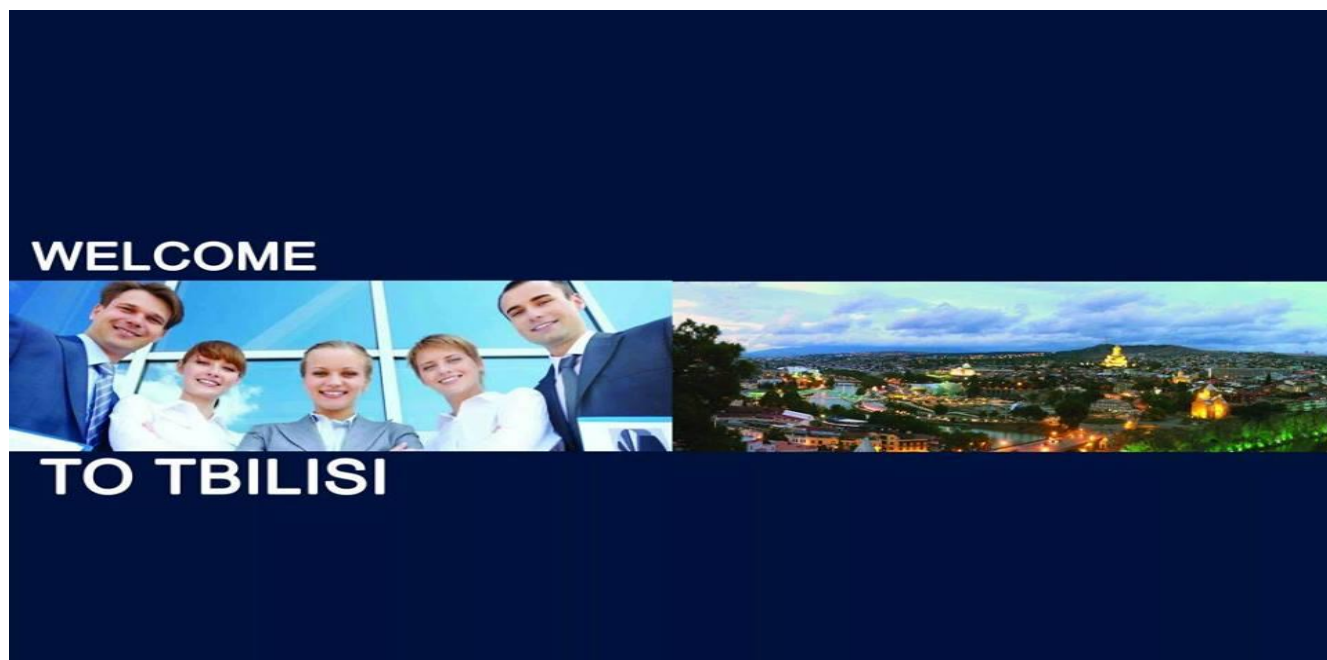
